Read: Reread the parable in Luke 12:13-21 and this time continue reading the passage to hear the follow up advice and encouragement that Jesus gives to his disciples in verses 22-34. As you read these verses, imagine yourself sitting at Jesus' feet; as though you were one of the people in the crowd.

Reflect: How would our American culture respond to the attitude and words of the Rich Man in the parable?

Would you say that your attitudes towards money, security, and generosity are more in line with the culture you live in, or the words of Jesus in this passage? Why?

Respond: This week, review your calendar and your budget. What is one way you can be more generous with your time, talents, or treasure in the coming year?
