²¹ Then Peter came to him and asked, "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?" ²² "No, not seven times," Jesus replied, "but seventy times seven!

- Matthew 18: 21-22 (NLT)

The Kingdom of God is about forgiving others – fully and freely with no limits.

²³ "Therefore, the Kingdom of Heaven can be compared to a king who decided to bring his accounts up to date with servants who had borrowed money from him. ²⁴ In the process, one of his debtors was brought in who owed him millions of dollars. ²⁵ He couldn't pay, so his master ordered that he be sold—along with his wife, his children, and everything he owned—to pay the debt. ²⁶ "But the man fell down before his master and begged him, 'Please, be patient with me, and I will pay it all.' ²⁷ Then his master was filled with pity for him, and he released him and forgave his debt.

- Matthew 18:23-27 (NLT)

King Jesus forgives our million-dollar debts!

²⁸ "But when the man left the king, he went to a fellow servant who owed him a few thousand dollars. He grabbed him by the throat and demanded instant payment. ²⁹ "His fellow servant fell down before him and begged for a little more time. 'Be patient with me, and I will pay it,' he pleaded. ³⁰ But his creditor wouldn't wait. He had the man arrested and put in prison until the debt could be paid in full. ³¹ "When some of the other servants saw this, they were very upset. They went to the king and told him everything that had happened. ³² Then the king called in the man he had forgiven and said, 'You evil servant! I forgave you that tremendous debt because you pleaded with me. ³³ Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, just as I had mercy on you?' ³⁴ Then the angry king sent the man to prison to be tortured until he had paid his entire debt. ³⁵ "That's what my heavenly Father will do to you if you refuse to forgive your brothers and sisters from your heart."

What does it mean to forgive?

What forgiveness is not:

- Forgiveness is not a feeling.
- Forgiveness is not weakness.
- Forgiveness does not mean forgetting.
- Forgiveness does not excuse the wrong.
- Forgiveness is not the same as reconciling.
- Forgiveness is not based on the wrongdoer's actions.
- Forgiveness is not conditional.
- Forgiveness is not about justice.
- Forgiveness is not about changing the other person.
- Forgiveness does not mean trust.
- Forgiveness is not about changing the past, it's about changing the future.

What forgiveness is:

- Forgiveness is a decision a conscious and intentional choice.
- Forgiveness is releasing bitterness.
- Forgiveness is a decision to grow and move forward.
- Forgiveness is obedience to Jesus.

Jesus invites us to experience the freedom and joy of forgiving.

Going Deeper: kingdomstories.db.church

Read: Read the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant twice, using the NLT translation. Focus on the king the first time and his servant the second time. Journal your observations about their emotions and responses.

Reflect: What prompted Jesus to tell this parable? What emotions drove the actions of the king and the servant? When it comes to forgiveness, what is your initial reaction to being wounded by someone? How do your emotions drive your reaction?

Respond: Think about the forgiveness God has given you. Receiving God's merciful forgiveness can result in deep gratitude which opens the door for our forgiveness of others. Ask God to bring someone to mind you need to forgive. What might God be saying to you about opening your heart and letting go of your unforgiveness? With gratitude for God's forgiveness, ask Him to help you take steps toward forgiving your offender.
