¹Then the Kingdom of Heaven will be like ten bridesmaids who took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. ² Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. ³ The five who were foolish didn't take enough olive oil for their lamps, ⁴ but the other five were wise enough to take along extra oil. ⁵ When the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep. ⁶ At midnight they were roused by the shout, 'Look, the bridegroom is coming! Come out and meet him! ⁷ All the bridesmaids got up and prepared their lamps. ⁸ Then the five foolish ones asked the others, 'Please give us some of your oil because our lamps are going out.' 9 But the others replied, 'We don't have enough for all of us. Go to a shop and buy some for yourselves.' ¹⁰ But while they were gone to buy oil, the bridegroom came. Then those who were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was locked. ¹¹ Later, when the other five bridesmaids returned, they stood outside, calling, 'Lord! Lord! Open the door for us!' 12 But he called back, 'Believe me, I don't know you!' 13 So you, too, must keep watch! For you do not know the day or hour of my return." - Matthew 25:1-13 (NLT)

Going Deeper: kingdomstories.db.church

Read: In your preferred Bible translation, read the parable (Matthew 25:1-13) twice through. When you read it the first time, place yourself in the position of the foolish bridesmaid. The second time through imagine you are in the role of the wise bridesmaid. Journal your perceptions as to how the two distinct groups responded to one another and to how the bridegroom responded to both the foolish and the wise.

Reflect: As you reflect on the parable and today's sermon, ask yourself two questions. What do you feel is the motivation of Jesus in the telling of this parable? What is the response from you that Jesus intends with this parable?

Respond: Think about what you can do and perhaps not do throughout your day so you can place more "oil in your lamp" and prepare your heart for Jesus.

² There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? ³ When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.
