"Again, the Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. He called together his servants and entrusted his money to them while he was gone." He gave five bags of silver to one, two bags of silver to another, and one bag of silver to the last—dividing it in proportion to their abilities. He then left on his trip. Becoming a good and faithful servant brings God's "Well Done!" Ask yourself...

- 1. GOOD What good thing has God given me?
- 2. FAITHFUL Am I faithful with what I've been given?
- 3. **SERVANT** Am I living my life as a servant of God?

Going Deeper: kingdomstories.db.church

Read: Read the Parable of the Talents slowly, several times. Jesus was always very deliberate in the choice of the words he would use. In the context of the story, what words stand out to you and why?

Reflect: As you think through this parable, place yourself in the position of each of the servants. Try to see the motivation for the hesitancy of the third servant. Are there any distorted views within you that prompt a similar hesitancy? Also, think about how beautiful the words "well done, my good and faithful servant" must have sounded to the first two servants. Imagine living a life when there will come a day when God might say those same words to you.

Respond: Write down your honest view of God's character and being. Read 1 John 4:7-21. Does your view of God match the words of John, who lived with Christ?
