CONSTRUCTION WAS COMPLETED IN JANUARY AND DAYBREAK AT ORRS BRIDGE ROAD'S GRAND OPENING TOOK PLACE ON FEBRUARY 21. OVER 230 ADULTS AND KIDS ARE ATTENDING WEEKLY FOR SUNDAY SERVICES, DISCOVERING AND DEEPENING A LIFE-CHANGING RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS.

AS PART OF OUR YEAR 2 WORK AT GETTYSBURG PIKE, WE'LL BE PURCHASING NEW WORSHIP CENTER CHAIRS. THROUGH A REACHOUT TO OTHER AREA ALLIANCE CHURCHES, WE HAVE DISCOVERED THAT WE ARE ABLE TO BLESS FAIRLAWN COMMUNITY CHURCH WITH ALL OF OUR CURRENT GP WORSHIP CENTER CHAIRS TO HELP THEM FIT OUT A NEW COMMUNITY CENTER THEY BUILT TO HELP TRANSFORM THE LIVES OF CHILDREN AND TEENS FOR THE GLORY OF GOD.



WORK HAS BEGUN ON THE GETTYSBURG PIKE BUILDING THROUGH THE PARTICIPATION OF MORE THAN 45 PEOPLE AT OUR FIRST GETTYSBURG PIKE WORKDAY ON APRIL 10. THAT WORKDAY WILL BE THE FIRST OF SEVERAL. THE MORE WORK OUR CHURCH FAMILY DOES AT GP IN 2021, THE FARTHER WE CAN STRETCH OUR CONSTRUCTION DOLLARS.



# CHURCH FINANCIAL UPDATE

As 2020 wrapped up, we found ourselves dealing with the net sum of higher Wide Open Year 1 expenses (in order to finish the OBR building), lower Year 1 income (the pandemic hit our November & December giving projections hard), and a lower Year 2 income projection than initially projected.

**The ramifications of these things were that:**

1. We needed to dip into our reserves to cover portions of our final 2 OBR construction bills.
2. We needed to both lessen scope and consider alternative financing for us to be able to complete some sizable, necessary infrastructure updates, as well as some strategic renovations at GP in 2021.

**In the face of these challenges, God provided through you all and in other crazy, cool ways.**

After income being only at 80% of projection for the months of November & December, both February and March saw giving significantly over projection. Through a partnership with LinkBank, we were able to refinance both our GP and OBR mortgages. The GP refinance allowed us to get an additional \$1 million cash out from our GP equity for GP renovations, lower our interest rate by .6%, and get 1 year of interest only payments to help with cash flow. The OBR refinance allowed us to move from 25 years to 20 years, as well as lower our interest rate by .6%, saving us more than \$200,000 over the life of the loan.

**God is good and we continue to engage in dependent discernment on His leadership!**
