Supplies:

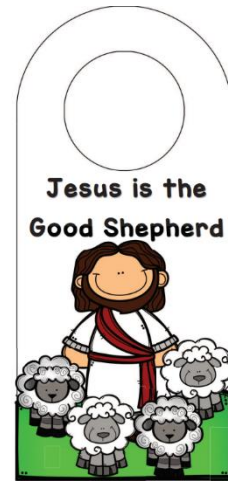
- Good Shepherd Door Hanger Handout (attached)
- Coloring Supplies
- Scissors
- Glue

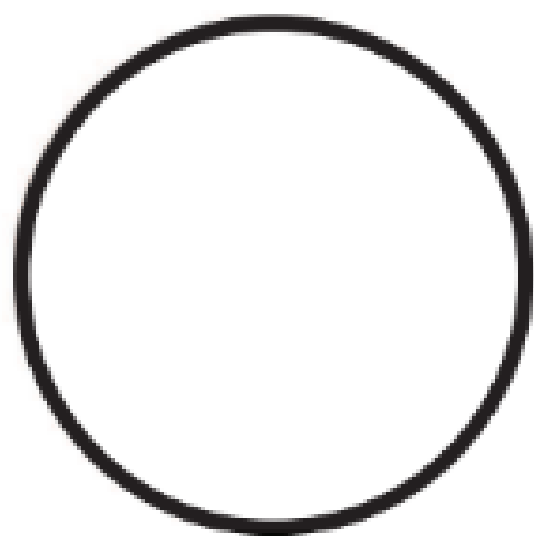
Prep Work:

1. Copy handout on white cardstock

Making Jesus Appear:

1. Color the doorhanger and sheep
2. Cut out the sheep (would work best to cut the sheep completely out vs. cutting on the box).
3. Glue the sheep around Jesus
4. Cut the Door hanger out. To cut the circle out, It maybe easier to cut a slit to slit and then cut the circle out.

Craft #2: Staff Mobile

Supplies:

- Staff and Sheep Handout (see 2 sheets attached)
- Coloring Supplies
- Brown Construction Paper
- String
- Scissors
- Tape
- Hole Punch

Prep Work:

1. Copy Staff handout on brown paper & sheep handout on white paper

Making Jesus Appear:

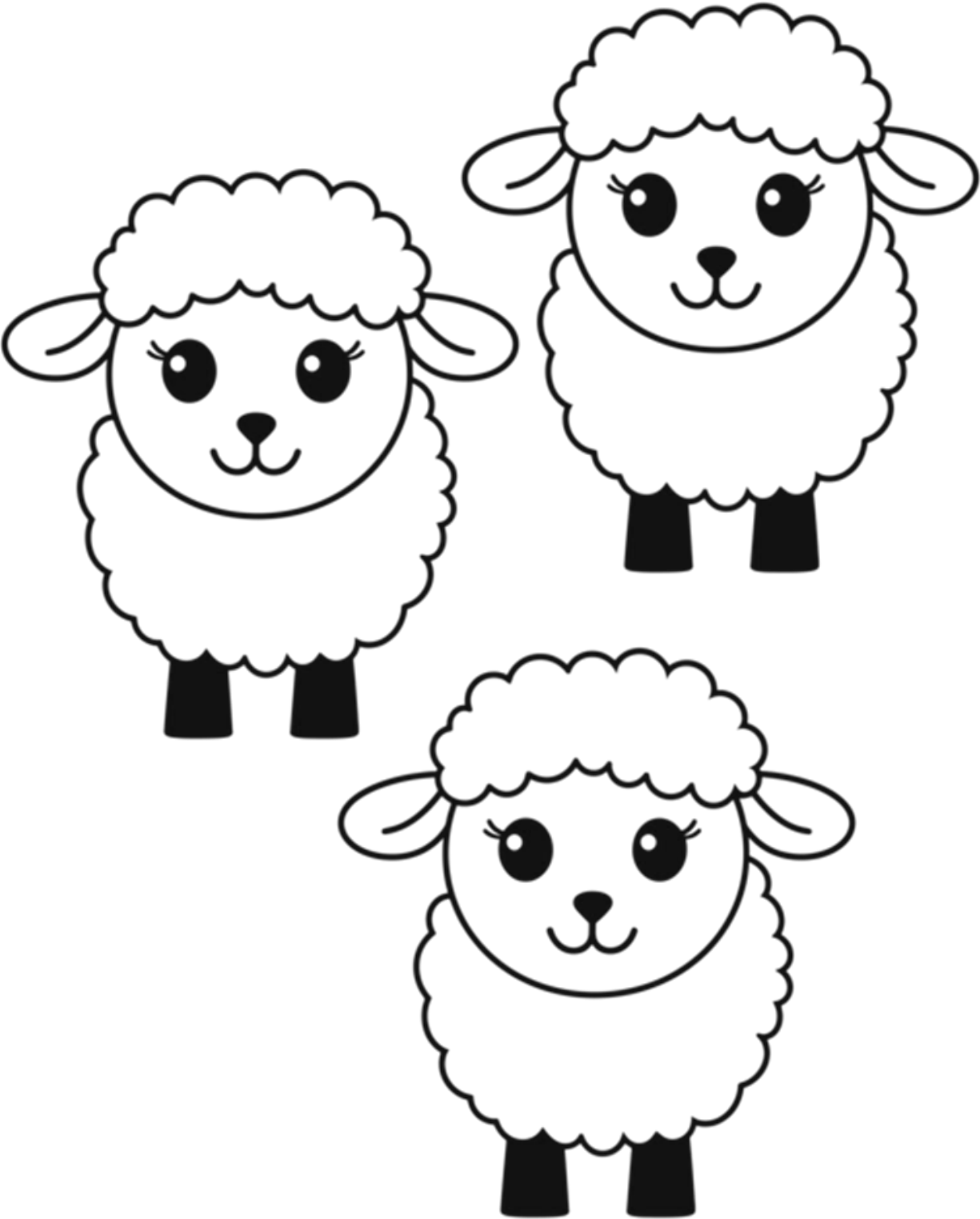
1. Color words on staff and sheep
2. Cut out staff and sheep
3. Punch holes at the bottom of the staff and attach string
4. Tape sheep cut outs at the end of the string
5. Punch a hole on the top of the staff to allow for hanging

Craft #3: Sheep

Supplies:

- Paper Plate
- Cotton Balls
- Sheep Head/legs Handout (attached)
- Scissors
- Glue
- White Crayon/Colored Pencil



Prep Work:

1. Copy the handout for the head and legs. Trace with white colored pencil or crayon on black construction paper.

Making Jesus Appear:

1. Glue cotton balls to paper plate
2. Glue face and legs to paper plate
3. Take a white crayon or colored pencil to draw on the sheep's eyes.
