Lesson: Early Believers Share

Craft #1: Finger Origami Puzzle

Supplies:

- Finger Puzzle Handout 1 per student (attached)
- Coloring Supplies
- Scissors

Prep Work:

1. Print out finger puzzle handouts one per student.

Making Finger Puzzle:

- 1. Color the pictures on the puzzle. Add background color (inside the square) if you desire.
- 2. Cut out the square area of the puzzle.
- 3. Fold in half, print laid face down.
- 4. Unfold and fold the other way in half.
- 5. Unfold and lay print side down. Fold the 4 corners diagonally in so the corners touch.






- 6. Flip the paper to the other side fold similar to step 5. (fold corners in diagonally so you can see the numbers in the corners.)
- 7. Fold in Half. Unfold and Fold in half the other way.
- 8. Put upside down and open "finger flaps" and pinch

together. It will now be ready to use.

To Play:

- 1. Have child insert their thumb and index finger from each hand into the flaps on the back.
- 2. Open and close the finger puzzle in different directions as you spell one of the words form the outer layer.
- 3. Pick a number from the inside and open and close the finger puzzle the number of times indicated.
- 4. Choose one more number. Open that flap and read what it says.



Craft #2: Gift Bag Decoration

Supplies:

- Brown Paper Lunch Bags
- Coloring Supplies
- Stickers/Foam cut outs/other decorating materials. (optional)
- Several Small prizes (candy, snacks, stickers, small dollar store toys, etc.)

Making Gift Bags:

- 1. Provide each student with a paper bag, and have them decorate it.
- 2. Provide several small prizes (candy, snacks, stickers, small gifts from the dollar store, etc.) & invite students to choose some of the items to put in their decorated bag.
- 3. Have them select someone to give it to (a friend, sibling, parent, etc.).

They can keep a few of the items they selected, but remind them of the importance of sharing.

Craft #3: Identification Badge (or Necklace)

Supplies:

- Construction Paper or Cardstock
- Stickers, Stencils, or Other Decoration
- Coloring Supplies
- Scissors
- String
- Hole Punch



Prep Work:

1. Select the size preferred for your "identification" (necklace or nametag/badge). Cut paper or card stock accordingly.

Making ID:

- 1. Write "I Spread God's Love by..." on the card, and have them answer the question either with word, picture, or both.
- 2. Decorate the rest of the card.
- 3. To make a necklace, place hole punches in the paper and attach string. For a badge, secure a safety pin or clip on the back.

Craft #4: Hands

Making Hand Craft:
