

## Junior Camp June 21, 4pm- June 26, 1 pm

Cost: \$110

## Family Camp July 10, 6 pm-July 12, 1 pm

Cost: \$140 per family before July 1 or \$160 after July 1 or \$70 per individual before July 1 or \$90 after July 1

A camp for youth entering grade 10 through graduating seniors. It's a great way to meet new friends and bond with old friends while growing in your relationship with the Lord.

Cost: \$125

### Scholarships

Scholarships are available for all first-time campers and any camper with financial need. Code is First2026 if registering online.

### Finances

The snackery sells pop, candy, t-shirts and hoodies. The cost is \$15 to \$25 for t-shirts and more for hoodies. \$30 is adequate spending for snacks at the camp store and any offerings. Youth deposit cash or checks at beginning of week and funds are deducted each snackery. Any remaining funds will be returned in cash.

### Health

A tetanus shot is advisable. Campers taking prescription medicines must bring their medicines in the original prescription bottle(s) and in a labeled zipper bag with the camper's name.

### Communication

Parents are asked to refrain from calling except for emergencies. If you must call, please be prepared to leave a message. Parents are encouraged to write letters mailed to the PO Box.
