### The Ruth Circle of Servants Donor Group

#### A. Purpose

- 1) Work together to be an extension of Jesus's love.
- 2) Create and nurture relationships with each other and with those we serve.

- 4) Support and advocate for Servants Mission

#### B. Eligibility

- 1) Donors must contribute \$500 in one calendar year. Membership is renewed annually.

#### C. The Ruth Circle serves God and our local, national, and international communities.

- 1) Plan and communicate one Home Helps volunteer day annually.
- 1) Plan and communicate one Disaster Recovery trip volunteer day biennially.
- 2) Plan and communicate one SARF trip for group biennially.
- 3) Plan and communicate one picnic day for group annually.
- 4) Plan and communicate one Saturday morning tea/coffee sessions for discussion
- 5) Plan and communicate one SARF education drive annually.
- 6) Each member will receive a bi-annual Women's Newsletter emailed.
- 7) Each member will receive an emailed invitation to all Women's group events.
- 8) A prayer group will be formed to pray for women in crisis.
- 9) A closed Facebook group will be created.
