### Introduction: The Gospel of Psalms 1 & 2

#### A. Four Voices Speak

1. The Rebellious Raging of the Nations (vv. 1-3)
2. The Royal Declaration of the Lord (vv. 4-6)
3. The Decree Spoken by the Son (vv. 7-9)
4. The Gospel Invitation to the Nations (vv. 10-12)

#### B. Three Truths Revealed

1. All people, in their fallen nature, hate God and resent His rule.
2. The Kingship of Jesus is universal, absolute and unrivaled.
3. Everyone is called to repent and to seek refuge in King Jesus.

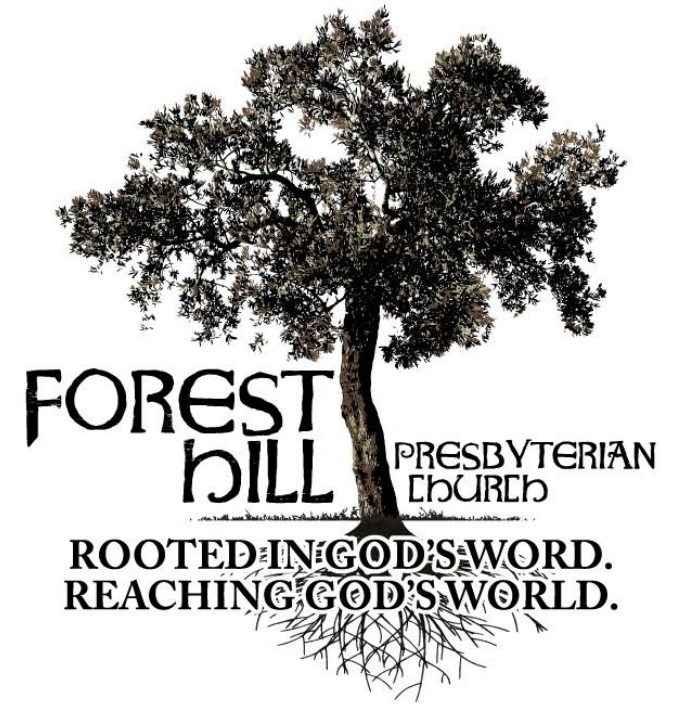
