### C. Our Portion in the Blessed Man (Application)

1. The Holy Spirit Teaches us the Truth of His Word (vv. 1-2)
2. The Son in Us Makes Us Fruitful (vv. 3-4)
3. The Father Declares Us His Forever (vv. 5-6)

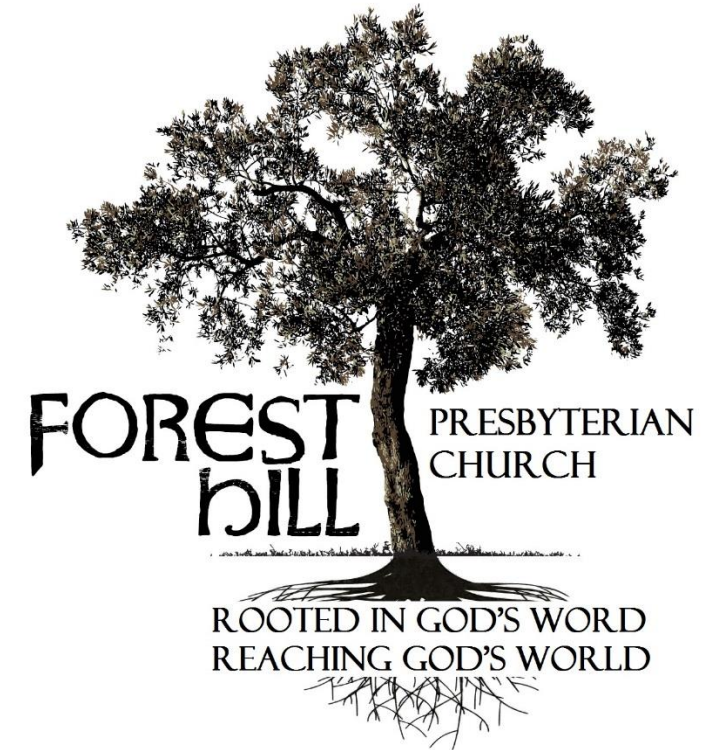
