Today's Message

These next chapters of Genesis tell of how Joseph prospers and then again finds himself in trouble. The text says, "The Lord was with him." Joseph was sold as a slave, but the Lord was with him. Joseph was imprisoned unjustly, and the Lord was with him. He was forgotten by the butler but the Lord remained with him. The music band Chumbawamba sings a song called "Tubthumping." Maybe you've heard it — "I get knocked down, but I get up again, you're never gonna keep me down." That's kind of what's happening to Joseph here. The apostle Paul wrote, "If God is for us, who can be against us?" We know this, not "triumphalistically," as if we deserve it, but humbly, by grace. Because even in the middle of our worst trouble, we still belong to God. And nothing is going to change that. (see Romans 8:30-39)
