

IMMIGRATIONS AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE)

After worship Sunday, December 30, several people asked if there were specific things that they could do to help with people who have been released by Immigrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and who are awaiting hearings. I spoke with a Presbyterian Pastor in El Paso and found numerous ways that assistance can be offered. Interestingly, they spoke positively of ICE and noted that ICE is simply being overwhelmed and that many people working for ICE are as concerned for the well-being of these people as well. Obviously money would be a help for these many ministries that are offering food, shelter, and transportation. He also noted that they have a great need for volunteers. If some of you would be available, they need people to help with food preparation, driving, working at overnight shelters etc. The churches could provide volunteers traveling down to help with very rudimentary food and housing. They can use any responsible adult and of course Spanish speakers would be even more helpful. If anyone would like to know more about this, I have the phone number of a pastor who is highly involved with this ministry and who can also refer you to other ministries that are engaged in this work in the greater El Paso area.
