### SAD NEWS FROM PITTSBURGH

Like many of you, I was saddened to hear about the shooting in the Pittsburgh synagogue on Saturday. Eleven lives were lost and six others were injured. Our hearts and our prayers go out to those families whose lives will forever be affected by the hate-filled actions of one gunman. These men and women of Jewish faith were murdered in cold blood. They just wanted to gather in peace. Instead, their lives were cut short. How should we respond?

- First, we should get down on our knees and pray for the victims and their families. We must pray that God will strengthen them and help them through this most difficult time.
  - Second, we must recognize that there is evil in this world. Bad things can and do happen, even to people who believe in God.
