This is in accord with Paul's writing in Ephesians 4.11-16: ***"It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ...From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work."***

ON SUNDAY

- When leaving the house on Sunday morning for Bible class and worship, pray for the church: the elders, deacons, ministers, teachers and every member of your church family.
- When you approach the church building, leave distracting thoughts behind.
- When the worship begins, lift your voice to God in song and bow your head as you approach his throne in prayer.
- When listening to the reading of God's Word and the sermon, let the words and their meaning impact your mind and heart.
- When observing the Lord's Supper, think about the gravity of His sacrifice.
- When giving, be generous and cheerful and thank God for your blessings.
- At the close of the worship services, greet our visitors first and *then* speak to those you know.
- When you leave the building, decide that you will do better this week than you did last week.

Every Sunday, ask yourself this question: "Am I truly worshiping God? Or am I just attending worship?" I want to encourage you to faithfully attend the worship services and classes on Sunday and Wednesday. And remember, we must "worship Him in spirit and in truth."
