MYOB

MYOB is widely recognized as an abbreviation for "mind your own business." Some people may be surprised to learn that this is a Bible command. In 1 Thessalonians 4.11-12, Paul writes, *"Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands, just as we told you, so that your daily life may win the respect of outsiders and so that you will not be dependent on anybody."* Paul says we should not meddle in things that do not pertain to us. We should not gossip about others. We must not be spread rumors or be nosy. Instead, we need focus on what God wants us to do in our lives and for his kingdom.

Some matters, however, are our business. If a brother or sister in Christ is living a sinful life or teaching error, we must warn and teach them. *"Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently" (Galatians 6.1).* James concurs: *"My brothers, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring him back, remember this: whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins" (5.19-20).* If our fellow Christians fall away from the church assemblies, it is our business to encourage them and exhort them (Hebrews 10.24-25).

So let's follow Paul's advice this week. MYOB.
