\$50 per person—four person scramble.

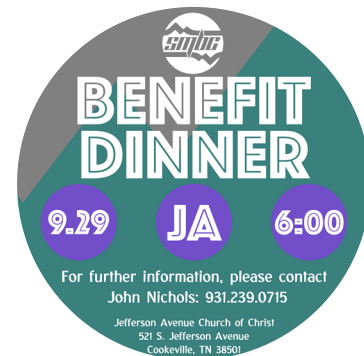
