Remodeling Children's Wing

On July 9th we will begin remodeling our floors in the Children's wing. This will result in a shutdown of that wing for about 2 weeks. - **Entrance through the South Doors and Old Auditorium hallway will be blocked.** Those members parking and entering through that side of the building come around to front entrance area of new auditorium.

- **Sunday Classes of July 15th and 22nd Modifications**

Nursery, Cradle Roll, and our Toddler/2yr Classes will take place in our newly completed nursery area in hallway behind the baptistry.

3yrs to Kindergarten will meet in gym.
