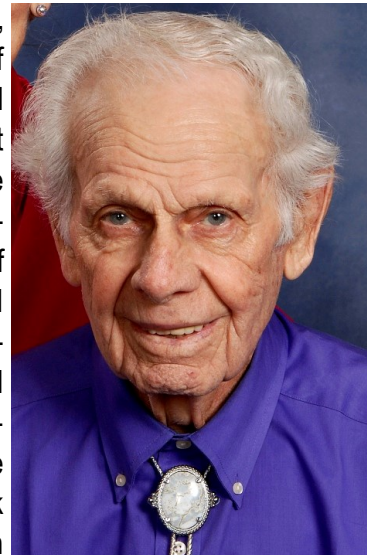

Collins' Corner

John 20:19-29

As you read this text, notice how Thomas wasn't with the disciples when Christ appears to them to show them his scars and to bring them peace. Thomas was absent from his friends and absent from the Lord, and because of that, he doubted.

If we are not careful, doubt can take over our lives.

You can probably think of scenarios and seasons of your life where you doubted. For Thomas, he had lost his leader. The one that he put his faith and truth in was gone—he didn't know what to believe anymore. That's not uncommon for us, too, is it? Whether it be when we lose a friend, family member, job, loss under the wrong circumstance can lead to doubt. Doubt can also find itself into our lives through the company that we keep, through sickness and brokenness.

If our faith in Jesus defines us and permeates through every aspect of our lives, then our doubting in Christ will do the same. It will affect every area of our life. If our life as a follower of Jesus affects how I live, how I work, my extracurriculars, how I interact with other people, how I interact with my family, how I view school, all those things. If my Christian life affects those positively, for the better, then don't you think when I'm unsure about my faith, those things will also be affected?

Don't you think if I live a life full of doubt that it will impact my family? My job? My hobbies? All of the things that my relationship with Jesus is potentially supposed to impact will also be impacted by uncertainty.

I can't tell you that this is a foolproof solution. I can't tell you this will work every time. But let me submit this to you: if you find yourself in a season of doubt, I would like to ask you this question—When is the last time you spent time in the presence of the Lord? When is the last time you spent time, real time, in His Word, in prayer, in creation, or with his people? If you have a hard time answering that question, I would offer that you might know the reason that you are doubting. You might know the reason that you no longer have peace. I would suggest to you, if you want to have the peace that only the Lord offers (we can't manufacture it) to spend time in his presence. If you want to have the confidence that only the Lord offers, spend time in his presence. If you want to know the reality of what it means to follow Jesus all the way into eternity, spend time in his presence.
