## Update on our friends – February

**Wesley & Rebekah :** Thank you for praying! We went a month without illness! We are so thankful for a house. This was a huge answer to prayer as it is extremely hard to find family houses to rent. Thank you for praying regarding our Visa situation. The process has been complicated, dramatic and difficult. God has made it clear to our leadership and us that now is the time to take a long furlough. This will give us time to set up our next Visa which will not allow us to come home for a visit longer than 30 days per year for the next 5-6 years. We will also work on raising much needed support. We have entered level B1 of language learning. This is the third level of six levels. Please pray as we chip away at this difficult language. Wesley recently attended a Roma Network Mentorship Conference in Serbia where he was amazed at the things God is doing among the Roma.

**Nathan & Lynn :** Nathan's health has returned, and he was able to complete several large internal projects contributing to Bible translation, literacy, and scripture engagement. Lynn is officially the Director of Operations for SIL America's Area. She received a research grant that will cover her costs to travel for data collection towards her doctoral program. Please pray for safety and good opportunities along her extensive journeys in 2026. We have two large financial prayer requests. One of Nathan's medications has increased in price from \$10/month to \$567/month. In addition, we took a voluntary pay reduction in 2025 so we could continue working for Wycliffe but are still in need of increased monthly financial commitments to continue. We currently need \$1500 more per month in commitments. We have depleted our savings. **Marvin C:** I want to let you know that I have retired from serving as a missionary (to the Mormons) with Missions Door, effective December 31, 2025. I have been with them for 64 years. I am now 92 years old and still in pretty good health, but I am slower at doing things. I usually walk one to three miles a day and go hiking but at a slower rate. I will continue to do what I can to help Utah ministries. I still have a good supply of books and tracts that I wrote on Mormonism and would be glad to send any of it to those who can use it. I want to thank all of you who have prayed for our ministry over the years. God bless you abundantly. Bethany financially supported Marvin from 1968-2020.

**Anna Kay H:** Please keep her in your prayers. Her husband had Parkinsons and Alzheimer for a lengthy period of time. He quickly declined in the past few weeks, and God called him home the beginning of January. Bethany financially supported them as missionaries from 1970-2021.

## Operation Christmas Child and Samaritan's Purse

At Bethany, we are well aware of the ministry of Operation Christmas Child, a division of Samaritan's Purse. Together we have worked to collect, purchase, sew and prepare items to pack in children's shoeboxes in November. But Samaritan's Purse does so much more around the world...

On October 28, 2025, Hurricane Melissa made landfall in Jamaica as a category 5 storm, bringing sustained winds of (185 miles) per hour and leaving a broad path of destruction on the island. The storm displaced tens of thousands of people, damaged or destroyed more than 100,000 structures, inflicted costly damage on farmland, and left the nation's forests brown and battered. On Oct. 30, Samaritan's Purse's, Disaster Assistance Response Team (DART), arrived on the island nation providing medical care, clean water, and shelter materials to thousands of Jamaicans. They have airlifted 10 plane loads of relief supplies, as well as nine thousand gift-filled shoeboxes to Jamaica through Operation Christmas Child.

We are honored to Partner with Samaritan's Purse in such a small way. God is using Christian organizations such as Samaritan's Purse to further his kingdom, and local churches, both stateside and globally, have opportunities to partner with them.
