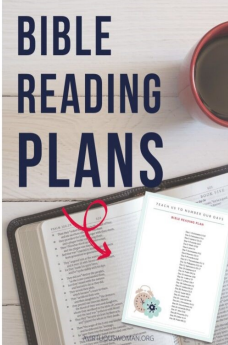

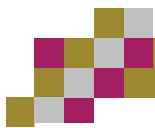

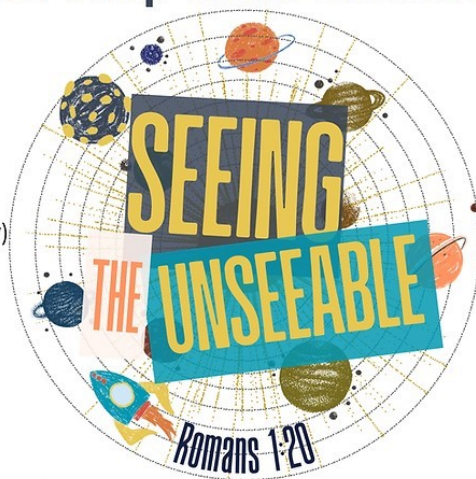

"I felt out of place as they were church planters and ministry leaders and I make software." I strived to explain in nerdy detail all the ways I am connected to what people think of as "real work," justifying my position. During a closing panel I learned that more than half the missionaries depended on Paratext for some aspect of their ministry. They told stories of how the software is woven into their daily translation work. At that moment, something clicked. I wasn't outside the real work-I was a part of an invisible chain connecting thousands of translators around the world through the tool we make. Paratext is used by more than 14,000 translators in nearly 3,800 languages. Let's honor the ways that God has wired each of us to play a part in spilling His overflowing love into the world. Please pray for wisdom as the design team remakes the 30-year-old Paratext into the new Paratext 10 Studio.

Mission 2911

Mission 2911: What is it?

Mission 2911 is Bethany's attempt to raise money for projects around Bethany that are not included in the yearly operations budget. One project that the Leadership would like to address is the Sanctuary. The windows were recently done, and the Leadership would like to continue to address and update other parts of the Sanctuary in different phases. At the Annual Business Meeting in November, the Deacons with the support of the Trustees and Finance Committee recommended **the challenge of raising \$60,000 to begin the next phase of replacing the flooring and seating in the Sanctuary.** The hope is to raise the money over the next several months enabling us to complete this project during the summer of 2026.

The Challenge

To replace the carpet and provide comfortable, beautiful new seating, the estimate shared at the Annual Meeting was approximately **\$60,000**. While that sounds like a large number, it is one of the most attainable goals we have—especially compared to the cost of a new parking lot or an elevator.

The Next Step: "260 - 260 - 26"

The equation is simple: We have right around 300 regular attendees. If **260** people contribute **\$260** over the next **6** months, the project would be fully funded and completed in **2026**. That's only \$1.50 per person per day. Thus the formula: 260-260-26. As always, we are committed to walking with you and we lean on the promise of God found in the namesake of this endeavor:

*"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord,
"plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
Jeremiah 29:11*

Once funds for this project begin to accumulate a subcommittee will be formed to look into the different options available for flooring & seating to recommend to the Congregation.

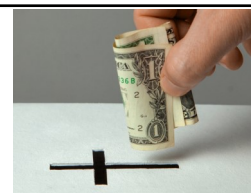


Your Donations to Bethany - 2026

Annual giving statements will be generated electronically in mid-January and sent via email. **(If you'd like a paper copy, please let the office know.)** In order to more effectively manage the funds donated to Bethany, here are some suggestions that allow us to be better stewards of what God has entrusted to us as there are costs incurred with the collection of funds.

- For those using online payment methods, switching from debit card to ACH would save a substantial amount of money. The fee for debit cards ranges from 2.2% for larger amounts up to 32% for smaller amounts. For a person donating \$200, Bethany only receives \$195 and the bank gets \$5. For 2025 (thru Nov), the total fees for debit cards incurred by Bethany were over \$400.
- With the exception of debit card usage, aggregating donations as much as possible would generate some cost savings. For example, for each donation via ACH, there is a .30 fee per transaction. If someone donates \$100 per week, the fees for the year would total \$15.60, whereas if the donations were once per month, the fees would only be \$3.60 for the year.
