Update on our friends – October

Wesley & Rebekah: When we stepped off the plane last July, we came here with two main goals: share Jesus with others and be "learners". We have been able to do both. There is really no way



to be totally prepared to jump into a new life overseas. We have had some tough problems and spiritual warfare such as many episodes of sickness and our little daughter being snubbed daily by local children. Thankfully, the kids we minister to have accepted her! This summer we were able to minister in two villages to children who have no Christian influence in their lives. We also had a "preschool" class to help prepare 7 - 8 year-old children who were starting school with very little readiness causing them to be held back. The parents are seeing an incredible difference in their children. We have a big prayer request. We have lost quite a few financial supporters and have learned we are under budgeted for multiple things. We have been dipping into savings and need to raise \$2000 per month in additional support. Please pray with us as we look to God to provide.

Nathan & Lynn: Please pray for us as we transition to life in America and for wisdom as we work remotely supporting the transition team in Central America, the leadership team in North and South America and missionaries across the globe. Praise God Lynn was able to pack up the remainder of our belongings in their previous location, bringing back some, storing others and selling the remainder.

We have taken a voluntary pay reduction but are still in need of \$1250 monthly financial support. **Lee and Lonna:** TransWorldRadio has appointed a new Chief Operating Officer, Steve H, who was the Chief Financial Officer. Lonna has worked with him in the past and has been asked to move to new offices with him. Her job will be changing. Their daughter, Melissa, has left teaching and is now living with them and looking for another type of work. Thanks for your prayers during these transitions.

Tim & Katie: RENEW, the high school program Katie leads has started well with twenty-one students. The principal said she asked a student about how her first weeks of school were and the student mentioned attending RENEW and had not realized how much she needed that kind of spiritual encounter. The dean of students also commented about how much the students appreciated having a space to stop and think about faith. In an encounter with a former principal of a school, He told Tim "if it hadn't been for Christian missionaries from America, I would never have come to Christ." You (Bethany) are part of this God-driven spiritual current, especially the part that relates to us here in Asia. Your prayers are essential, and your interest encouraging. Your financial gifts help us travel to the places where Tim speaks and help provide Bibles to international students. Thank you for standing with us.

Ev and Jan: (retired): We have seen an influx of new people coming to church. Most have come through finding us on the internet. Several new people are unsaved family members of current believers. Please pray for their salvation. Ev received a clean bill of health from our cardiologist and Jan's heart is functioning better.
