With grateful hearts, we want to take time to thank each of you for the incredible support you have given to ATLAS throughout this past year. We are deeply thankful for you and for the vital role you play in sustaining and strengthening the work God has entrusted to ATLAS. Because of your support, ATLAS is able to continue serving as a place of hope, healing, and community for those who are hurting. Your partnership allows us to continue reaching people who are searching for guidance, encouragement, and restoration. Each gift, each prayer, and each volunteer hour helps make it possible for us to keep our doors open and our mission moving forward. This year, your faithfulness helped make a powerful impact:

- **75 women** were served through mentoring relationships
- **34 men** were served through mentoring relationships
- **376 individuals** attended our fellowship groups
- **509 people** participated in our growth groups
- **322 individuals** joined our Bible studies
- **42 children** attended our children's events

These numbers represent far more than attendance—they represent lives changed, burdens shared, faith strengthened, and hope restored. Behind every statistic is a story of someone who felt welcomed, supported, and reminded that they are not alone. Because of you, ATLAS has been able to walk alongside individuals and families as they navigate some of life's most difficult seasons.

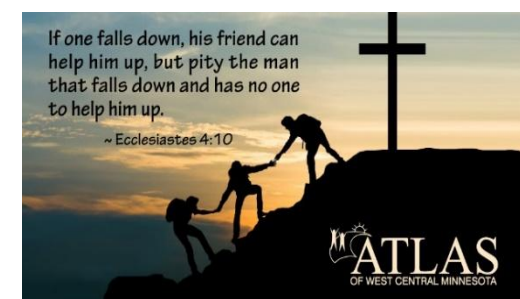
