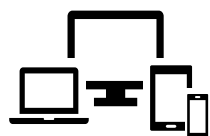

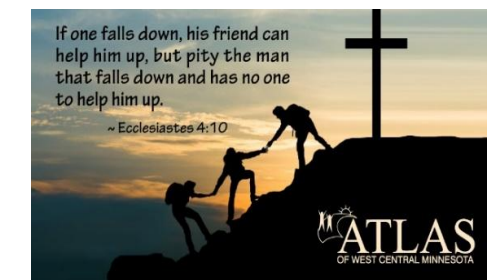

## SAFE HARBOR NEEDS YOU!

Safe Harbor exists to provide transitional housing for homeless families, not just a roof over their heads, but a pathway to stability, healing, and hope. In a world where homelessness is often hidden behind closed doors, in cars, motels, or overcrowded living situations, Safe Harbor steps in to offer a lifeline to families caught in crisis. This is more than a housing program. It's a restoration ministry.

We believe every family deserves a safe place to call home, where children can sleep in peace, parents can breathe again, and dignity can be restored. At Safe Harbor, families receive not only shelter but tailored support services: individualized case management, life-skills training, tenant education, budgeting and debt management, employment assistance, parenting support, mental-health resources, emotional support and spiritual mentorship. Our program is unique in that we lead families to Jesus to help them discover root causes, remove barriers, and walk toward lasting change.

The Safe Harbor House Program serves one- and two-parent families experiencing homelessness. Families may live in the house for up to twelve months (with extensions available if needed). Through close partnership with ATLAS staff, volunteers, churches, therapists, and community organizations, residents work toward employment, access needed services, and locate permanent housing. Participants are offered an incentive savings plan, receiving monetary incentives for completing program goals so they can save toward a down payment or first month's rent on a new home.

We cannot do this alone. We need our Christian community to share the gospel not only in words but through love in action, to pray, to volunteer, to mentor, and to give financially. Becoming a mentor, prayer partner, volunteer, or financial supporter helps our community immensely. Collaboration with churches, therapists, other Christian nonprofits, and local partners is key to bringing families from living in darkness to living for Jesus and finding salvation.

A generous donor has gifted a house to ATLAS for our Safe Harbor ministry, a lifesaving opportunity for families experiencing homelessness. To make this house a permanent, welcoming home we must move it, purchase a city lot, add a basement, and complete renovations. The total project cost is \$274,000; thanks to early generosity we already have \$145,000 and are seeking the remaining \$130,000 to complete the work. We need your help

When we step out in faith, God does the impossible: He turns broken hearts into testimonies, despair into hope, and ordinary people into kingdom builders. God is calling us to step in, stand up, and bring His light to those who desperately need it. When God's people rise up, hope rises too, that's why this matters.
