## **A Good Samaritan**

By the time, age 20 something, Yvonne (not her real name) found JRM, it was already late on a Friday afternoon and JRM had closed for the day and for the weekend. Temporarily here in Minneapolis from her home in Northern Minnesota, Yvonne was really in a jam. She had encountered a group in her home town who had made their way up north from Minneapolis for the funeral of a family member. With the funeral concluded, they promised to fill her gas tank to the brim in Minneapolis if she would just drive them back to Minneapolis. from up north. Having a decent car, enough gas to get to Minneapolis and no other pressing commitments, she decided to be a Good Samaritan and help them with the needed transportation.



When they arrived at their destination here in Minneapolis, they all jumped out of the car and scattered, running several different directions and disappearing between houses and behind fences. Yvonne was abandoned, hurt, confused, and bewildered. Unfamiliar with Minneapolis, only \$4.00 cash in her pocket (not nearly enough to buy gas needed for the trip back) and not much more than fumes left in the gas tank, she fought a growing sense of fear and desperation. She didn't know anyone here in Minneapolis. that she could bunk in with for the weekend or get cash from, and

friends in her hometown had no way to get money to her. The one JRM staff person who had Providentially stayed late to finish a project, found a way to get enough gas for her to solve her dilemma. You or I might have used a credit card or a check in the absence of cash. She had neither one. What she did have was the Lord's Provision through your "light shining" gifts, prayers and caring.

Super relieved and now anxiety free, she was grateful beyond words. As she tried to thank us, we pointed to God's love as the source of the caring and the help. **She joined us in thanking the Lord,** and then was on her way, wiser and more careful because of the experience of the day.
