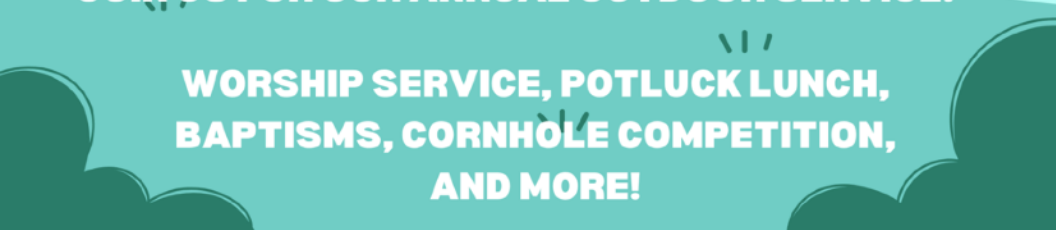

SIBLING CONFLICT CHART

The heart behind our magnetic Sibling Conflict Chart is to provide both Scripture and consistency when resolving conflict between siblings.

With different sides on the double-sided chart for the one who sinned and the one who was sinned against, the chart walks through Scripture, prayer, and action to bring reconciliation and peace between siblings.

SIBLING CONFLICT Management FOR WHEN YOU HAVE SINNED AGAINST SOMEONE	Step 1 THINK BEFORE YOU SPEAK	Step 2 EXAMINE YOUR HEART (FOR SINS)	Step 3 MAKE IT RIGHT WITH OTHERS	Step 4 FORGIVE THE OTHER PERSON	Step 5 TRUST ONE ANOTHER OUTSIDE
If...	SCRIPTURE	PRAYER	ACTION		
You say something hurtful	<i>Proverbs 12:18</i>	Pray that God would use your words to bring healing to others.	Say 3 nice things to the sibling you hurt.		
You take, break, or ruin something	<i>Matthew 7:12</i>	Pray that God would help you treat others the way that you would want to be treated.	Try it. Give the item back or buy them a new one. Ask if you can do extra chores to earn the money to make it right.		
You hurt someone physically	<i>James 1:19-20</i>	Pray that God would help you learn to love others through your actions, even when you're angry.	Apologize for your anger, help them to feel better by getting them an ice pack, cool washcloth, band aid, etc.		
You are dishonest	<i>Colossians 3:9-10</i>	Pray that God would help you learn to always speak the truth, even when it's hard.	Tell the truth about the thing that you lied about.		
You are bragging or prideful	<i>Proverbs 27:23</i>	Pray and ask the Lord to help you walk in humility.	Encourage your sibling by complimenting them.		
You are whining or complaining	<i>Philippians 2:14</i>	Pray that God will help you grow in joy and thankfulness.	Think about how to express your feelings without whining or complaining. Write 3 things that you are thankful for.		
You are trying to get your sibling in trouble or being a tattletale	<i>Matthew 18:15</i>	Pray that you will grow in your love for your sibling and in wisdom about handling difficult situations.	Confess your wrongdoing and apologize to your sibling and parent.		

Remember: FOR ANY CONFLICT, IF RESOLUTION CANNOT BE REACHED, TALK TO AN ADULT AND GET THEIR HELP!

PRAYER	ACTION		
Pray that God will help the person you hurt to bring joy and peace to others.	Say something nice to them. Give them a compliment, or simply smile and walk away.		
Pray for help handling the situation in a Christlike manner. Ask the Lord to help you love people more than things.	Remind yourself that everything belongs to God and humbly ask your sibling to help you fix the problem.		
Pray that your sibling grows in peace and learns better ways to behave when they are frustrated.	Allow them to help you feel better. Don't let them. Make sure to talk to your parent or teacher about this.		
Pray that God will allow you to use your sibling through life's joys.	Tell your sibling something that you love about them.		
Pray that you grow in patience and confidence. Pray that God helps to build your heart for holy joys.	Once you have patiently waited for your turn, kindly ask for your sibling to share.		
Pray that your sibling and you will allow the Lord to allow the Lord to come out and for each other to love and in love for one another.	Consider your part of the trouble. If you're sibling is in the wrong, read Proverbs 15:1. Be a peacemaker who is in a fault, work to make it right.
