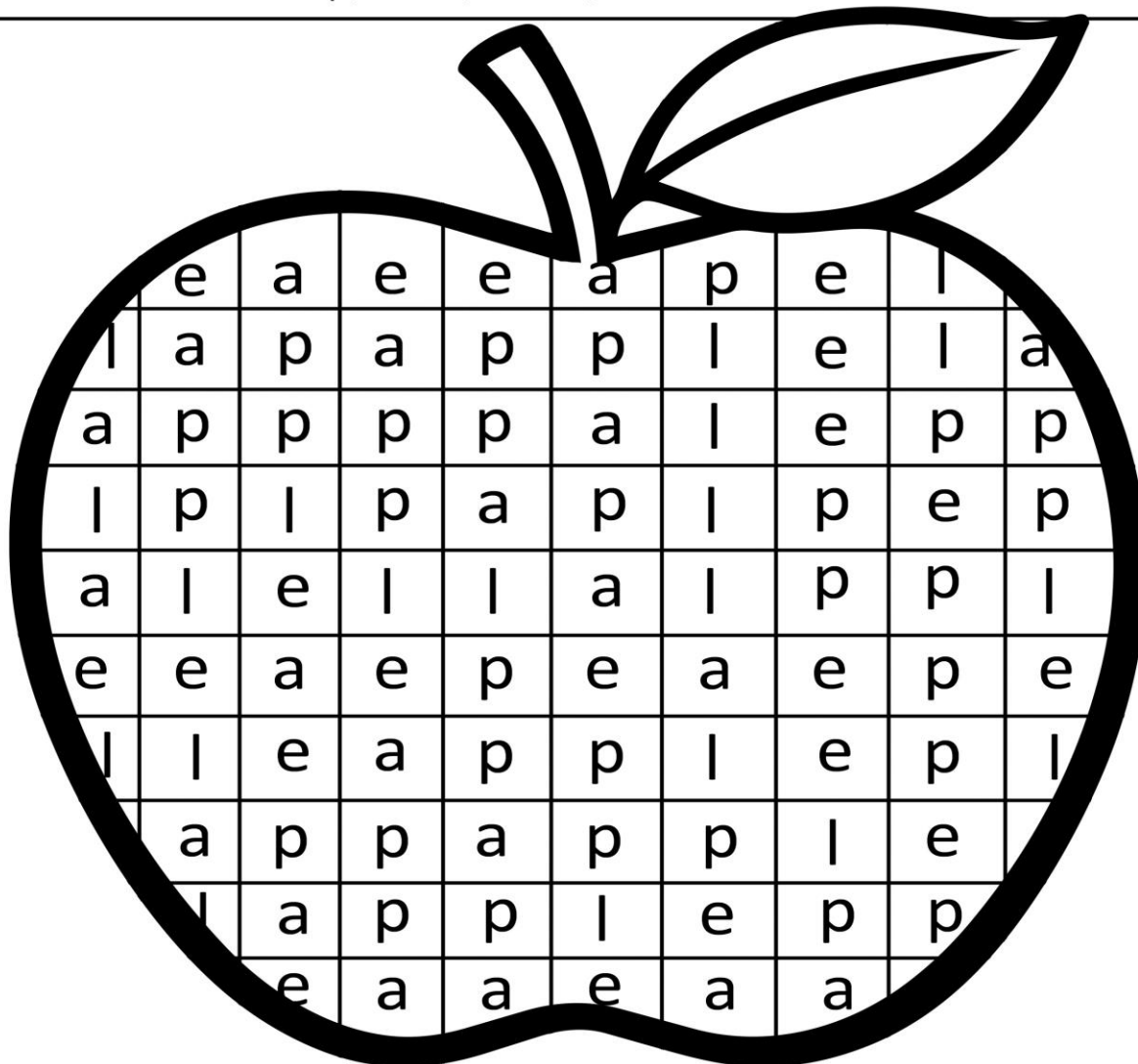




Apple of Your Eye
