



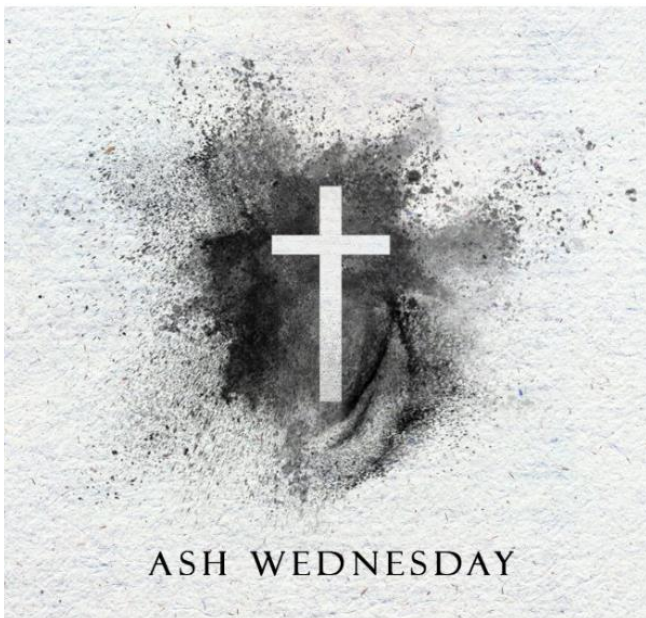

Hey Church Family,

It is almost time for one of my favorite moments of the year, Ash Wednesday. The Ash Wednesday service will be Wednesday, February 18th, 2026 at 6:45 p.m. in the sanctuary. We will have our regular Wednesday night Primetime meal at 6:00 p.m. There will also be children's Caswell kids starting at 5:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday is the start of the season of lent. Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection.
