Holy Week and Easter 2024

Hey Church Family,

This Sunday begins Holy Week and kicks off with Palm Sunday. It is a thrill to be a pastor during this pinnacle of the Christian year. I am praying now for us all to experience God in new and powerful ways. Here is our schedule:

Palm Sunday - Sunday, March 24th, 2024 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

During this service the children will wave Palm branches remembering Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. I will preach a sermon from Luke 5:1-16 called *Boatloads of Grace*. The service will conclude with a stripping of the chancel.

Easter Sunday - Sunday, March 31st, 2024 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

We will gather to remember the resurrection of Jesus Christ. During the 9:00 a.m. service the choir will share their cantata. We will decorate the empty cross with flowers. During both 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. we will have great music and a powerful message on God's love for us.

- On Monday, March 25th at 6:30 p.m. Mary Anne Cabbage and I will be at the town stage to help with worship. Rev. Joseph Brock will be sharing a message. Each night Monday - Friday there will be worship and a message at 6:30 p.m.

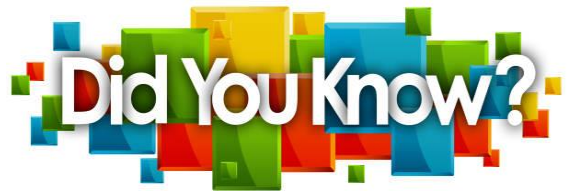
