50 and Plus Will be Having Lunch at the Farmhouse

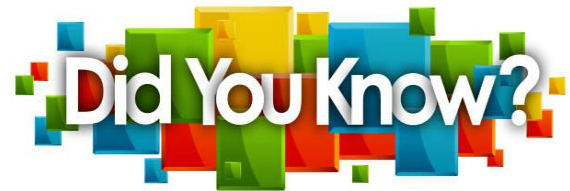
