#### What is Methodist Connectionalism?

The Glennville Methodist Church is a part of Methodism. Methodism was started in the 1700s as a movement to reform the Church of England. Some of the distinctives are emphasizing God's grace as well as continual growth in holiness as we pursue Christ. Methodist also emphasize this grace in works of mercy and charity to the world.

Another key concept in the majority of strains of Methodism is a word called **connectionalism.** This means we do not view ourselves as an independent isolated church. We view ourselves connected with the entire Body of Christ. We also view ourselves having a special connection in our denomination, the Global Methodist Church.

We have two ways we are going to demonstrate our connectionalism. This **Sunday, November 12th at 6:00 p.m**. in the sanctuary we will have our charge conference. This is a special meeting for the entire church where all church members will be asked to vote on next year's leadership and compensation. We are blessed to have the Rev. Issac Salgado joining us for this evening together. The meeting should be done in under an hour.

The second way we are connected is with our President Pro Tem. This is the title given to the leader of each annual conference in the Global Methodist Church for the moment. Rev. Jay Hanson is our President Pro Tem for all the Global Methodist Churches in Georgia. We are honored to have Jay as our speaker for **Harvest Sunday on Sunday, November 19th at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.** There will be a meal following the 11:00 a.m. service.

The Global Methodist denomination is lucky to have a church like Glennville Methodist. We are also grateful, by God's grace, to be connected to Global Methodism and the wider Body of Christ.




