Hey Church Family,

Thank you to everyone who came out for Primetime this past Wednesday! I had so much fun sharing about the 2026 General Conference of the Global Methodist Church, and I'm glad Brandy joined me in wearing our African attire.

This Sunday, we find ourselves between books in our Bible study. Last week, we finished 1 Samuel. Next week, on October 4, we will begin a seven-week study of Philippians, which will carry us to Harvest Sunday and the beginning of Advent.
