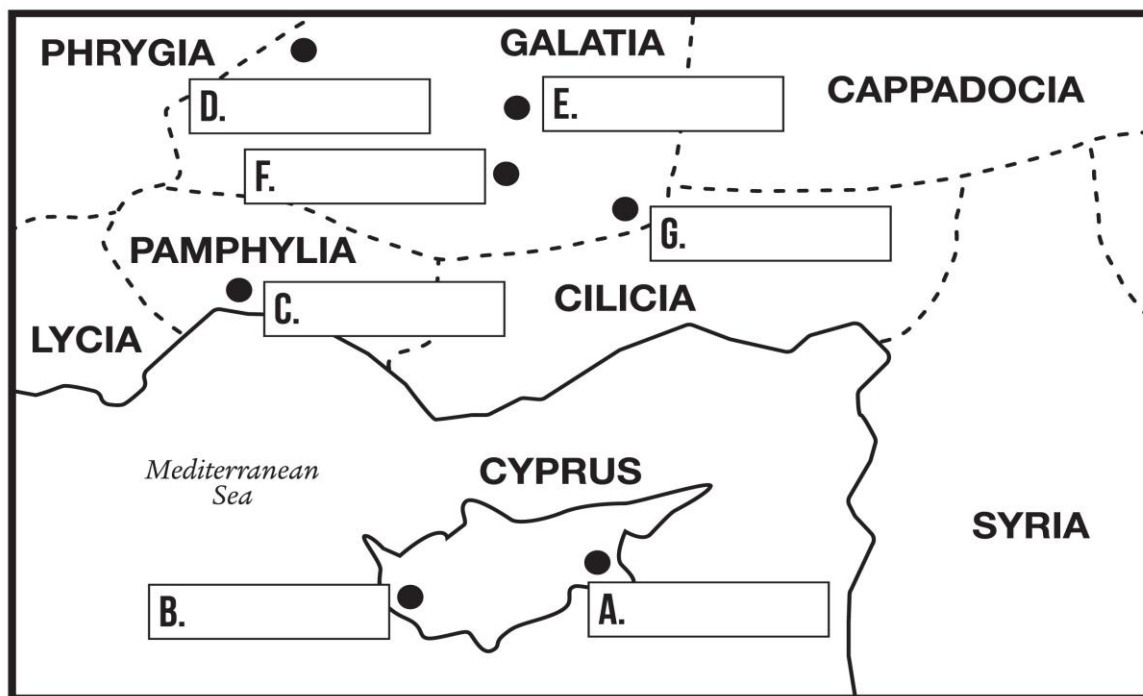
PUZZLE CITY SEARCH
