DECEMBER 3, 2023 FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

The beautiful season of Advent is upon us! Our Church, in her wisdom, begins a new liturgical year on this First Sunday of Advent, gifting us with an opportunity to begin anew, to renew our relationship with Christ, to prepare our hearts in a more profound way for Christ's indwelling. We are called to enter into a time of waiting and watching, longing and desiring, anticipating and expecting. By placing our advent wreath in a prominent place in our home and setting aside time for silence, prayer, and reflection on sacred scripture when lighting the first candle, we make a conscious effort to focus our attention on our relationship with Christ.

Isaiah's prayer of lament reminds us that we continually walk away from our relationship with God. We rebel then blame God for abandoning us! If we insist on going down the wrong path, God will not force us to do what is right. That's the freedom God gave us! God hopes that we will see the error of our ways; God nudges us; God waits and watches for us; God desires that we come home.

Advent is a time to reflect on our relationship with God and see our patterns of behavior concerning God. God continually calls us to live in hope, to see beyond our present circumstances to a future blessed by God, filled with restoration and transformation. God desires our whole being and wants what is good and beautiful and true for us personally and collectively as a whole.

Paul blesses us with God's grace and peace. The word grace is rooted in the Hebrew word *hesed*, which speaks of God's loving kindness, mercy, and faithfulness. Who we are and everything we have is because of God's grace. Are our hearts open to this grace? Do we live in the belief that God works with us, strengthens us, and continually invites us into a deeper relationship?

Mark clearly calls us to *beware, keep alert, watch, keep awake* at the start of this Advent season. He doesn't want us to be left behind; he doesn't want us to miss these opportunities to surrender our hearts to Christ. Christ is here yet he wants to be closer. He encourages us to keep awake so we will fling open the doors of our heart with reckless abandon, trusting in God's goodness and grace. Let us wake up to the active presence of God permeating every single moment of our days.

Jesus asks us to light this first Advent candle so warmth and welcome will flow from our heart homes as we shine God's grace into the world, lighting the way for others to enter God's kingdom. Let the Holy Spirit be our doorkeeper. May we be ever watchful and alert as the light from each of our candles scatter the darkness and infuse the world with God's grace and peace.


