1st Reading: Isaiah 11.1-10 † 2nd Reading: Romans 15.4-9 † Gospel: Matthew 3.1-12

THEME: FROM BROKENNESS TO WHOLENESS

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is the second Sunday of Advent. As a family of God's people, we continue to move in the hope of receiving the fulfillment of God's promise through our ancestors in faith. This Sunday, the church reminds us that while we are sustained by the great hope of the Lord's coming, we have to heed the voice of the one crying out in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make his path straight".

Beloved, I am greatly moved by the words of Isaiah: "there shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit". This is a beautiful image. From the dead, rotting, and decaying stump of Jesse (King David's father)—a broken dynasty that was apparently going nowhere—God will unexpectedly cause new life to shoot forth. This a very wonderful and hopeful life god offers. God does not abandon his people, instead, in continuity, works to bring new life out of death through a descendant of David. Where there is brokenness, God creates hope. Where there is darkness, God's light shines forth.

God is graceful and initiates this process of creative transformation, but God needs us for God's dream to be realized in the world. Transformation requires pruning, and destruction of old ways of life. Our souls need purification. Most importantly, the cleansing waters of baptism must be preceded by a change of heart and lifestyle. This will move us from brokenness to transformation and to complete healing. Repentance, reconciliation, and holiness of the heart are the prerequisites for justifying our hope at the end of this season. Therefore, let us rid ourselves of everything hindering us from receiving Christ this season. In light of this, I humbly encourage you to take advantage of the sacrament of reconciliation to prepare yourself to receive our Lord and King.


