### THEME: HERE I AM, LORD! I COME TO DO YOUR WILL

Dear People of God,

Today is the second Sunday of Ordinary Time, Year A. On this Sunday, the Church presents to us through the prophetic insights of Isaiah and John the Baptist the “Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world”. One very remarkable lesson that the Church wants us to learn from this Sunday’s readings and reflection is that the Lamb of God was more than a “mere servant.” He is a son who obediently fulfilled the will of the Father.

In today’s gospel, John the Baptist identifies and vividly presents the Saviour to the world. By this act, John has completed his mission and the will of God. It was for this reason that he was called to be a prophet. He has obediently accomplished his mission. Therefore, John is a perfect example of how we ought to approach our call and the will of God for us. All we need to do is to accept it, and the Holy Spirit will confirm our efforts. It is our mission to present Christ to others as John did: “Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world”. Both Christ and John the Baptist have played their roles as far as doing the will of God is concerned. So, we must continue that same mission.

Finally, to do God’s will perfectly, we must be in tune with the Holy Spirit. God will supply the grace that we need to do his will. The Holy Spirit will give us the power and strength we need to fulfill our mission. If we remain docile to the Holy Spirit as John the Baptist was, he will reveal all we need to know. He will teach us the best way to carry out the mission. So, let us say with the psalmist: “Here I am, Lord! I come to do your Will.”
