## JANUARY 25, 2026 THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

1st Reading: Isaiah 9.1-4 † 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1.10-13, 17-18 † Gospel: Matthew 4.12-23

### THEME: COME CLOSER TO CHRIST THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Dear Friends in Christ,

We should seek and walk in the light of God, the good news. This is the light that draws us to Christ. In the first reading, Isaiah raises our hope. This hope comes from the fact that God has manifested his light on us. It is a message of deliverance from the power of darkness that formerly harassed us. Isaiah declares: "The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light; on those who live in the land of deep shadow, a light has shown". God's light breaks our yoke and shows us the way. It clears our doubts and fears and increases our confidence in God and ourselves.

Today's gospel fulfills the prophecy of Isaiah through the action of Christ. His presence made a tremendous difference in the lives of the inhabitants of Capernaum and those of the neighboring towns of Zebulun and Naphtali. His light was strongly felt because it brought healing and deliverance. So, as instruments of God's light, our presence must make a positive difference wherever we are. It must dispel the darkness in people's lives. Are we making any difference?

Finally, today the Church beckons us to come closer to Christ, who says: "I am the light of the world". Wherever there is the light of God, darkness and quarrels disappear. Also, despair, fear, anger, betrayal, and all other vices disappear. Therefore, if we follow, and come closer to Christ, the light, then: "In His light, we shall see the light" (Ps. 36, 9).
