# JUNE 11, 2023 CORPUS CHRISTI

Jesus gave his Body and Blood so we could share in his life. In a world of so many hungry hearts literally and figuratively, that statement should cause us to ponder! We are the people Jesus offers to feed—not with a temporary fix (which is usually what most of us want) - but an everlasting source of sustenance that can be found in the change of heart that happens each time we gather to share a meal in Jesus' name. Christ offers us his body and blood, and when we eat and drink; we, in turn, become part of the Body of Christ. That is what we believe about the Eucharist. Unity is what our sacrament of Communion is about: oneness with God and each other. Yet, because we are human, Communion is necessarily paired up with another sacrament that does the work of reconciling. When unity gets torn, reconciliation repairs the damage. Lately, toxic polarization has been shredding our national unity, creating an illusion of insurmountable division. Media sources sharpen the knives of contrasting worldviews, leading to anxiety and depression, fear and violence. Trust in unity. Resist being recruited in the polarization game. Saint Maximilian Kolbe echoes Jesus's invitation, the culmination of the Mass is not the consecration, but communion.

What is really at stake here is that Jesus is the source of life for us. To the extent that we dare to give ourselves over to him, we may become new men and new women. If I may oversimplify a bit, the change that Jesus wants to bring about is not so much aimed at the bread and wine, but at us. When we eat this bread and drink the wine, we profess our faith in Jesus and we become one with him, so that his life becomes ours; eating this bread and drinking this wine are signs of an encounter with Jesus himself, because it is his flesh and blood. Jesus' self-giving, his flesh and blood, is handed on to us, so that his self-giving may become flesh and blood in us.

These gestures, however simple, turn our lives upside down. Let's face it: our world is often like a battlefield, where people tear each other to pieces - like war and endless violence in actions, words and gestures. But what we do here in this sacred ritual is precisely the contrary! It shows the exact opposite of what we too often see lived. It shows us Jesus giving himself. When we eat and drink here, we accept the life of Jesus as our own. We let him be the norm of our dealing with each other. When we eat and drink here we do not put flowers on the grave of someone who is dead. On the contrary, we let our lives be shaped and permeated by him who still lives, but now in us. We eat the bread and drink the wine in memory of Jesus, with the hope that his self-giving may become flesh and blood in us. Hence, my final question for you to ponder this week: does participating in the eucharistic celebration make you feel more alive? Frederica Green asked a very poignant question - could a body broken, and blood spilled 2,000 years ago restore my own damaged life? My answer, yes, yes, yes... eyes on Jesus!
