JUNE 4, 2023 THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

We're returning to Ordinary Time, which is time ordered toward daily Christian growth in faith. It doesn't imply that "extraordinary time" is behind us for the next 25 weeks. Discipleship can be a heroic summons in any hour. The Holy Trinity, whose feast we celebrate today, is beyond the reach of time and the grasp of human reasoning. It is a mystery of our faith. Trinity Sunday isn't for explaining the Three-in-One. It's an invitation to meditate on the mutual self-giving of Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier, who "so love the world" that we all share in the divine embrace.

There are Three Persons in the Trinity, the Father the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Together they represent the fullness of love. The Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father. The Holy Spirit is their love for each other. God is love. We are made in the image of a triune God. God the Father, who created us, his Son who saved us, and the Holy Spirit who continues to guide us. Our lives should reflect the Trinity. We should be always creative like the Father, compassionate like his Son, and dispose our talents in the service of others like the Holy Spirit. Bernard of Clairvaux wrote...if we are right to think that the Father gives and the Son receives the kiss, we do not err in thinking that the kiss itself is the Holy Spirit.

Behind all the theology, though, let us remember the word: love. The love within God, the love God has for the world, and the divine love in which we, too, have a share. Saint Paul offers a wonderful prism through which to consider the Trinity: the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. Scripture texts support the revelation of this divine love. And so instead, then, of trying to indulge in theological acrobatics or worrying about formulas, let us instead try to enter a relationship with these three Persons, through whom God is revealed to us. "Brothers and sisters, put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you." That is what it is all about. **The Trinity is a family of love**.

While I am away with our priests on our annual retreat this week, let us all take some time to become aware of our Trinitarian God, a God who loves us into being, who is our Beloved as we are God's Beloved, and whose love weaves us together as the Body of Christ. "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" – a Trinitarian blessing and protection that tells us whose we are as we go about our days and nights in the safety of God's love. Love is on the table.... come...eat...and go and light the fire of love in someone's heart! As you may know, I had to say goodbye this week to my dog Ben after 17 plus years. My heart is broken but memories sustain. My life will be less because of his absence but is more because of his presence! I pray that Ben is in the safety of God's love, and I know that loving my beloved dog is a part of the great mystery of our Triune God!


