NOVEMBER 23, 2025 CHRIST THE KING

1st Reading: 2 Samuel 5.1-3 † 2nd Reading: Colossians 1.12-20 † Gospel: Luke 23.35-43

THEME: EXALT THE UNIVERSAL KING OF GLORY

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this thirty-fourth and last Sunday of ordinary time, the Mother Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Universal King. Today, we exalt Him as the Sovereign Ruler of the universe. Pope Pius XI instituted the feast of Christ the King in 1925 in response to growing nationalism and secularism with the title "Jesu Christi Regis" (Our Lord Jesus Christ, the King). However, in 1969 Pope Paul VI gave the feast a new title, "lesu Christi universorum regis." (Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe).

In the first reading of today, the entire Israelites united in making David King. The reason is simple. They saw in him a worthy servant. He did not impose himself on them. Instead, they genuinely and unanimously acclaimed him their king. Our people will bear joyful testimony to our capability to lead them.

In today's gospel, Pilate and the Jews ignorantly conspired to castigate Christ, their king. Rather than accepting him, they hardened their hearts to God's call to share in his kingdom and glory. Our celebration today is not a mockery as the Jews. Instead, it is a genuine celebration of the universal reign of our Lord Jesus Christ. Christ, the universal king, is a role model to all kings, rulers, presidents, decision-makers, and leaders. He cares, loves, and lives in peace with his people. He does not rule with iron fists, military might, or financial strength. He is a good Shepherd, a just judge, and a compassionate king. He is the only king who treats us as his brothers, sisters, and friends.

Christ, our universal King, is divine, yet he shares in our humanity and allows us to share in his kingly and priestly nature (Rev 1:6; I Th 2:12). He is ever close, and no special protocols are required to reach him. So, brethren, let us celebrate because the Lord comes to rule his people with fairness. He will reign forever and will give his people the gift of peace.





Tiptap Donation Update:

We've reached another milestone in the modern age with the introduction of a Tiptap donation device at both church entrances. This makes donating easier and more accessible for everyone who visits our church. For those who may be unfamiliar, the Tiptap device allows you to make quick, contactless donations using your debit card or credit card or phone by simply tapping the device. Donations will be processed securely and it is a safe and convenient option, especially if you don't have cash or your envelopes with you.

Tiptap donations can be included in your tax receipt if you give us a little information. We will need the last 4 digits ONLY of the debit or credit card that you used along with your name and address. <u>This has to be given to the office only once</u>. Thereafter the office will have a record on file for future donations. You can either email the parish office or fill out the information slip by the Tiptap devices. Full instructions are provided at the entrances of the church.

Note that your information is secure as only the last 4 digits of your card information is visible on the payment system. No other information is available. Please contact the office if you have any questions.




NEWS FROM THE DIOCESE

In recognition of the World Day of the Poor on 16 November 2025, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has issued a pastoral letter by the Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace titled "Our Daily Bread: Food Security and the Call to Solidarity." Centred on the themes of solidarity, harmony, and harvest, the pastoral letter highlights the current challenges to food security, both globally and in Canada. 
