THEME: A VISION OF HOPE FOR THE FUTURE

Dear People of God,

The Halloween combination of All Saints Day and All Souls Day, reminds us of the reality of death and life after death. Today we are remembering those we have known and loved — family members and good friends. Indeed, the whole month of November is a time when we remember our dead in a special way. The loss of a loved one brings with it sorrow due to a deeply felt absence in our daily life. We mourn the separation, even when it is not unexpected. But the pain of our loss is tempered and eased by our hope and trust in the Lord, in His mercy, and in His promise to grant eternal life to those who believe in Him. We cooperate with Him by praying for those who have died and asking the Lord to bring them swiftly to himself.

As Christians, remembering our departed loved ones before the Lord, praying for them, is one of the ways we give expression to our ongoing communion with them in the Lord. Today, we entrust our loved ones who have died to God. Jesus had compassion on the widow. He walked with the widow saying there is light, there is love and laughter and rejoicing, there is a life beyond our death.

Dearly beloved, come to think of the words of Jesus in the gospel according to John "and this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up at the last day" (6:39). Jesus could not lose those who are given to him and who are guarded by his Holy Spirit. If during our life on earth, we remain firmly united to Christ by faith, hope, and charity, how could it happen that Jesus would lose us? – If as Christians we remain faithful to the Spirit who stays in us, then Jesus will raise us up at the last day.


