NOVEMBER 30, 2025 FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

1st Reading: Isaiah 2.1-5 † 2nd Reading: Roman 13.11-14 † Gospel: Matthew 24.37-44

THEME: BE AWAKE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Advent Season is a season of expectation, preparation and penance, and most importantly of hope. The readings of Advent plunge us back into the times when God's people awaited the coming of the Messiah. The prophets spoke about the coming of the Messiah, thus keeping alive the hopes of the People of God. As we begin this season, let us take time to do a thorough examination of conscience to discern areas of weakness and sin – those "works of darkness" Paul talks about – in our own lives. Then, consider taking up practices that help you to foster the opposing virtues to arm yourself against these temptations. As you grow in these virtues, you'll certainly be on your way up the mountain of the Lord and walking in his light.

Today's Gospel calls us to vigilance. Jesus tells us, "therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come." While he is speaking about our need to be ready to meet the Lord when he comes at the end of our lives, it's also an invitation for us to always be ready to share our faith with others whenever the opportunity presents itself. We never know the moment when someone will come to us in need of prayer, a word of encouragement, or with questions related to their own spiritual hunger. We must always be ready to meet them where they are and offer a word of hope.

Take a moment to pray this week for those "divine appointments" – those individuals who might come your way – seeking encouragement or insight into the spiritual questions in their lives. Ask for the grace to be "awake" so that you're ready to meet them when they come. We can't always predict when these encounters will happen, but we can prepare ourselves to receive these persons as Christ and offer them our full attention and love. Therefore, we must not serve God with heavy hearts. We must be alive, awake, active in good works faithful servants of Christ our Master.

We've reached another milestone in the modern age with the introduction of a Tiptap donation device at both church entrances. This makes donating easier and more accessible for everyone who visits our church. For those who may be unfamiliar, the Tiptap device allows you to make quick, contactless donations using your debit card or credit card or phone by simply tapping the device. Donations will be processed securely and it is a safe and convenient option, especially if you don't have cash or your envelopes with you.



Tiptap donations can be included in your tax receipt if you give us a little information. We will need

the last 4 digits ONLY of the debit or credit card that you used along with your name and address. <u>This has to be given to the office only once</u>. Thereafter the office will have a record on file for future donations. You can either email the parish office or fill out the information slip by the Tiptap devices. Full instructions are provided at the entrances of the church.

Note that your information is secure as only the last 4 digits of your card information is visible on the payment system. No other information is available. Please contact the office if you have any questions. Thank you for your generosity in supporting St. Patrick's Parish.


