THEME: SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS

Dear People of God,

Today, Jesus reminds us that judgment belongs to "God who searches the mind" (Ps. 139:1). He is the one who knows all our intentions and actions. So, it is not for us to judge others because human judgment can be biased at times. What transpired between the publican and the tax collector is typical of the scenario we see every day.

Self-righteous people often judge others wrongly because of their weakness of mind and ignorance of how God operates. Such people look at themselves as role models that others must imitate or as if they are the only holy ones. They always wear the "holier than thou attitude". So, they are quick to condemn others. However, God judges differently.

Beloved, we must not place ourselves where we do not belong and place others where we feel they should be. Instead, we must humbly acknowledge our nothingness, vulnerability, and weakness before God, the Just Judge. 


