EXPECTATIONS

2. love God with all of their heart, soul, mind, and strength (Matthew 22:36-38).
3. be members of Woodlawn Baptist Church, actively involved in the life of the church.
4. be in agreement with the doctrines and practices of Woodlawn Baptist Church.
5. be growing in their knowledge of and love for God through the consistent practice of the spiritual disciplines, especially the study of God's Word and prayer.
6. be devoted to exemplifying humble servanthood (John 3:30). This will be reflected in seeking to not draw attention to themselves, seeking out and receiving input from others, valuing the varied giftings and contributions of others on the team, and joyfully accepting changing roles and seasons of service.
 - Modesty: both men and women must dress modestly. In the context of worship, this means dressing in such a way as to not draw attention to ourselves.
7. faithfully and punctually attend meetings and rehearsals.
 - Many of the positions in the worship band have depth; therefore, we are implementing a rotation. If you realize you are going to miss rehearsal or the worship gathering, alert Pastor Laramie as soon as possible, so that he can arrange a substitute.
8. be committed to growing in their musical skill.
9. willingly communicate to the appropriate pastor any circumstances, responsibilities, or patterns of sin that might affect the integrity of their participation on the team.
