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I. The backstory

- **Genesis 50:24**- And Joseph said to his brothers, “I am about to die, but God will visit you and bring you up out of this land to the land that he swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.”
- **Judges 21:25**- In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.
- **Deut 17:15**— you may indeed set a king over you whom the Lord your God will choose. One from among your brothers you shall set as king over you. You may not put a foreigner over you, who is not your brother.
- **Deuteronomy 7:14**- You shall be blessed above all peoples. There shall not be male or female barren among you or among your livestock.

II. A _____ family (1 Samuel 1:1-2)

- **Judges 13:1-2**- There was a certain man of Zorah, of the tribe of the Danites, whose name was Manoah. And his wife was barren and had no children.
- **John 6:9**- “There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are they for so many?”

III. Hannah’s _____ (1 Samuel 1:3-8)

- **Joshua 18:1**- Then the whole congregation of the people of Israel assembled at Shiloh and set up the tent of meeting there. The land lay subdued before them.
- **Luke 13:4**- And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, “In you shall all the nations be blessed.” So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.
- **Psalms 73:25**- Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you.
- **Philippians 4:19**—And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
- **John 15:5**- I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.
