FEED THE HUMMINOBIRDS!

Nectar: Boil tap water for 5 minutes.

Mix: 1 part white sugar to 4 parts preboiled (5 min) clean water until sugar is
completely dissolved. Pour into clean
hummingbird feeders, hang outside and
they will entertain you. Change the
water every 3-5 days and wash the
feeders with soap and hot water.

Change it more often when the weather
is really hot, especially if it's in the sun.
Bacteria growing in the feeder can kill

Extra nectar can be kept in the fridge for 5 days. Do **not** add food coloring to the water. It's toxic. Most feeders are red and that's the color that attracts them!


Blessing Box
