Any omission of the required documentation will result in your disqualification for a scholarship award. All applicants will receive fair consideration. The number of scholarships awarded is determined by the Scholarship Committee.

#### Jamestown United Methodist Church Scholarship Criteria

#### **Instructions for Applicant:**

- 1. Read the guidelines carefully.
- 2. Submit a personal statement/essay that reflects your goals, motivation, and reasons why you should be awarded the scholarship. Include statements about your personal faith journey.
- 3. All application forms and materials should be typed or written in a legible format.
- 4. All materials and completed application forms must be submitted online or if in print, place it in a manila folder with your name, address and telephone number clearly marked on the outside.
- 5. Deliver your application and required materials by February 22 or March 14 (references) by end of business day (4:30 pm) to one of the following:

#### **Eligible Requirements:**

- 1. Must be a graduating senior or General Educational Development (GED) recipient for the current school year.
- 2. Must be a <u>current member</u>, <u>affiliate member</u> or an <u>active participant</u> (you participate in the life of Jamestown United Methodist Church on a regular basis) of Jamestown United Methodist Church for at least one calendar year.
- 3. The applicant must have applied to his/her school of choice and must provide documentation of acceptance before an award is confirmed.
- 4. The scholarship award shall be reported to the recipient's school of choice upon delivered verification of registration to Jamestown United Methodist Business Administrator Shannon Craver by May 9, 2024. \*Form will be emailed to the applicant.

#### **Application Forms:**

1. Application forms will be available beginning on January 2, 2024. All applications must be returned to the church office on or before February 22. References are due no later than March 14. Applicants will be notified of awards during the month of May.

#### **Accompanying Forms:**

- 1. Each application must be accompanied by a personal essay/statement which must include the educational goals of the applicant, motivation, and why the applicant feels she/he should receive the scholarship.
- 2. Each application must have three names for letters of recommendation who will be contacted by email from the Scholarship Application. The recommendations should be from the following:
  - a. Recommendation from a high school teacher.
  - b. Recommendation from an employer or church member who is not on the Scholarship Committee (see list on last page).
  - c. Recommendation from a peer.

#### Interviews:

The Scholarship Committee may require more information from the applicants if it is deemed necessary. Applicants will be notified by telephone, email, or letter if this is necessary.
