Because Lent has traditionally been a season stressing prayer, study, fasting, and spiritual reflection many Christians may associate negative images of suffering and sacrifice with this season. Personally, we should think of Lent as a call for spiritual renewal; instead of a period of suffering, sourness, or discomfort. Even the practice of "sacrificing" something during Lent is not meant to promote suffering, but to free the time saved for spiritual pursuits, or free the money saved to help those less fortunate. Although our sacrifices and "sufferings" may help us focus on the sufferings of our Lord, the purpose of Lenten disciplines is not to suffer but to focus and improve our relationship with God.

That's why Triumph Church will host more than 25 services during Holy Week, the period from Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday. We celebrate the fact that Christ made the ultimate sacrifice for our sins so that we could have a right relationship with God and be with Him for all of eternity! He rose again to prove that he has power over both sin and over death.


