Part 2 – You are Not Alone

## MAIN POINT:

**As You Go: You Are Not Alone**

### EXPLORATION:

1. Read Matthew 28:19-20. Compare your version with this paraphrase: *“While you are on this journey called life, point people to follow of Christ by helping them to choose Christ and teach them everything you have learned from Christ.”* - K.M.P. How does reading it in the paraphrase change how you would apply the Great Commission?

*(Context Clues- “Make disciples” is a command. It is second person plural which indicates that it is for everyone. We should make disciples “as we go”, by “baptizing them” and by “teaching them everything the Lord has taught us”. So really everyone that is a Christian should be looking to bring others to be followers of Jesus wherever that believer goes!!)*

2. Read the following verses: Matthew 28:20, Joshua 1:9, Psalm 139:7-8, and Hebrews 13:5-6. What do these verses have in common? How does the promise that God is with you wherever you go encourage you in your efforts to share your faith?

*(Context Clues- It is interesting that the command is to make disciples as you go wherever you go and the promise is that wherever that is, God is with you there!!.)*

3. Read Luke 10:1-3. How does this passage emphasize the idea that when you go to share your faith, you do not go alone?
4. Read Matthew 10: 20. This passage promises that when you go to take a stand for Christ that the Lord will give you the actual words you are to say. Have individuals who have experienced this tell stories of how it happened.

### APPLICATION:

1. In light of the chalk board wall project, who will you invite to church? Who will you share your faith with? And who will you try to disciple or teach things that you have learned from the Lord?

#### *Chalk Board Project List:*

1. Invite to church
2. Share their faith and the story of Christ with.
3. Disciple or teach on a somewhat regular basis things they have learned about Christ, God, faith and the Christian walk.

2. Read Luke 10:1-3 and Ephesians 6:18. Who could you ask to help you in the adventure of sharing your faith with particular individuals? Who could you specifically ask to pray for you as you step into this commitment?

3. Pray for members of the group and River Point Community Church and the names, hearts, and souls of people that will be reached during the series “As You Go”.
