

Sermon Discussion Guide

He Shall Be Called – Prince
of Peace
December 24, 2017



MAIN POINT:

The Prince of Peace intends
for peace to prevail

ICEBREAKER: When do you feel the most at peace? Why? (Suggestions- after a snow, at home, in a deer stand, at the beach, during worship, with family)

EXPLORATION:

1. There are over 948 names and Titles for God in the Bible. Look up "948 Names and Titles for God" at Christiananswers.net. What are some of your favorite names for God and why?

(Context Clues- This is a repeat from the last weeks, but there are plenty of Names to share and celebrate.)

2. Read Isaiah 9:6-7. In this passage there are five prophetic truths about the Messiah. What are they?

(Context Clues- 1. He will be a Child. 2. He will Rule over God's people. 3. There are five descriptive names for the Messiah that reveal His character. 4. The Messiah will sit on David's throne. 5. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will do this.)

3. Read Isaiah 9:6. What are the five descriptive names that reveal the character of the Messiah?

(Context Clues- 1. Wonderful-exceptional, distinguished, 2. Counselor- knows what to do by His own authority, 3. Mighty God- fully Deity 4. Everlasting Father- Father and Son- Trinity 5. Prince of Peace)

APPLICATION:

1. According to Isaiah 26:3 how does one find true peace?

2. Read Philippians 4:6-7. According to this passage are peace and understanding the same? Which is more important? Why?

3. Read Colossians 3:15. How do you think a person let's peace establish a rule in their heart?

4. Read Hebrews 12:14. How can you help peace prevail in lives around you at this point in your life?

5. Take prayer request and pray for the members of the group. Pray for each to have a Christmas where the Prince of Peace and peace itself prevails.
